

# Mountaineer Inn COVID-related Guidelines for Indoor Gatherings

Expected Guidelines as of July 4, 2021

These guidelines will be in effect during your stay: Note: the front desk is open 8:00 AM to 6:00 PM

- Print out the attached registration form and have it completed and signed prior to arrival. You will need to leave it at the front desk in order to check in. Your electronic copy is considered your official copy.
- By signing the registration form I/We agreed to hold harmless the Mountaineer Inn in the event I/We am/are diagnosed with COVID-19.
- Your room has been cleaned using FDA and EPA approved products and guidelines.
- Your room has been sanitized using an UltraViolet Light and Ozone treatment. These technologies kill germs on surfaces and in the air.
- We have placed air purifiers in all our common areas. These filters include a True HEPA Filter which captures 99.97% of unseen particles down to 0.3 microns.
- We will not be servicing your room during your stay. However, if you would like your trash emptied, please leave your trash can outside your room by 10:00 AM and we will empty it. This is a guideline from the American Hotel and Lodging Association (AHLA).
- If you need additional supplies such as cups, towels, soap, etc., please come to the front desk.
- There is a supply of hot and cold cups for your beverages as well as creamers, sugar, tea bags and stirrers in your room. You will need to bring these items with you when using the coffee bar or having beverages in the public areas. Be sure to use hand sanitizer after you have touched the machine. You do NOT need to bring cups with you to the dining room during meals.
- Ice is available at the front desk and in the dining room during meals. Bring your ice bucket with you.
- A corkscrew/bottle opener is in your room.
- If you need help between 6:00 PM and 8:00 AM, please use the intercom on the wall to the right of the front desk.
- The public bathroom is reserved for attendees not staying at the Mountaineer. Please use the facilities in your guestroom.
- Automatic hand sanitizer dispensers are located in each common room and the lobby. Hand sanitizer pumps are located in other strategic areas.
- If you or anyone else sharing your room exhibit signs of illness or COVID-19 symptoms upon arrival you will not be allowed to check in.
- If symptoms begin during your stay you will be asked to leave and return home if possible. If departure is not possible, you must self-isolate in your room for the remainder of your stay. If you are required to extend your stay in order to self-isolate you will be responsible for nightly room charges. The Vermont Department of Health will be contacted immediately about your condition.
- Print out the attached registration form and have it completed and signed prior to checking in. Bring the completed form with you. You will need to leave it at the front desk in order to check in. Your electronic copy is considered your official copy.
- By signing the registration form you and other persons sharing your room agree to hold harmless the Mountaineer Inn in the event I/We am/are diagnosed with COVID-19.
- The registration packet includes a page with live links to review the current State of Vermont Out-of-State Traveler Guidelines.
- Make sure you have your last vaccine shot by July 29th. This way you will not need to quarantine prior to travelling to Vermont.
- All meals will be served “cafeteria style.” Please come in pairs or as a single.

- Please notice the signage on where to wait/stand prior to entering the dining room. Please wait for the server to indicate when to enter so you can be served.

The governor of Vermont is constantly changing and updating directives and guidance relating to the pandemic. The above guidelines are accurate as of May 1, 2021.
